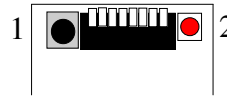


SETTING CAR RADIO



After having installed the interface, you would need to configure the C100 according to the car radio brand by choosing the dedicated software. Please follow the procedures explained below and. **NOTE that by default, C100 is usually set for ALPINE car radios.**

- Open the unit
Press LONG and hold the key (1) until the LED light (2) stays still
- then release the key (1)
- Repeatedly press SHORTLY the key (1) until you reach the number of flashes needed
- Now press LONG the key (1) again, until the LED light (2) stays still
Once this procedure is over, disconnect and reconnect the unit.



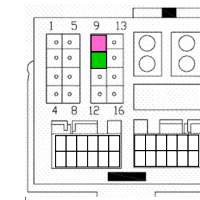
